Project Name
Project Type

2. Opening Summary (40-60 Words)

Provide a concise paragraph clearly explaining:

- What the project is
- Where it is located
- Who designed or developed it
- What makes it notable

3. Key Project Details (Bullet Format)

Include 4-6 short factual bullet points where possible:

- Project type
- Completion year
- Size (sqm / sqft)
- Sustainability features or certification
- Materials used
- Number of units or floors

4. Main Body Text (400-800 Words)

If possible structure the article using clear subheadings such as:

- Design Concept
- Architecture & Materials
- Sustainability & Innovation
- Community & Impact

Please supply a maximum of 6 high-resolution images separately with captions including project name and location and which is to be featured image.
